



Blended & Remote Learning Agreement 2021-2023

St Joseph and St Theresa's will:

- Provide a mixture of live and or recorded lessons, independent activities, and other relevant tasks (i.e. on Google Classrooms, Purple Mash, Times Table Rock Stars) to continue learning at home
- Respond to completed assignments/tasks through Google Classrooms and Purple Mash
- Provide appropriate tasks for pupils who have an IEP or are on an EHCP
- Provide live sessions for children to interact with their class teacher and peers - these will not be recorded
- Provide recorded teaching for English and Maths lessons
- Contact pupils who do not log in to live lessons to check in on them and their family
- Offer pupils the opportunity to ask for extra help if they don't understand

Pupils will:

- Attend all live/recorded lessons unless they have a genuine reason that they are unable to
- Leave profile pictures as initials so that they are easily identifiable in the lesson
- Find a quiet place to join their live lesson and have a pencil and paper to make jottings
- Remember class expectations still apply - always adhere our school rules, see also the Google Classroom expectations
- Remain on mute unless the teacher asks for them to unmute
- Focus on learning during live/recorded lessons
- Use the 'Raise your hand' function to participate in the lesson and use the 'Chat' function when instructed
- Use the chat function for learning ONLY, this is not a social media chatroom
- **NOT** screenshot or record live lessons or copy any information, messages or posts
- Complete set activities on Google Classrooms, Purple Mash and other follow-up activities to practice skills
- Only access the material shared by their teacher and ask for parental permission to use technology for anything beyond that using safe search skills for web browsing
- Read daily, either independently or with an adult

Parents will:

- Ensure their child is following the daily timetable and completing their work
- Let the school know if their child has any technical issues with accessing online learning
- Be aware that screenshotting or recording live lessons or copying any information, messages or posts to share on social media or any other platform is strictly prohibited
- Report any absences - where your child is unable to access home learning due to illness or for another acceptable reason
- Ensure their child only uses the platforms for educational purposes
- Monitor the use of their devices for access of other online materials and apps
- Contact their class teacher during normal school hours (8:45am - 3:30pm) through if they require support of any kind, and understand that the teacher may not be able to respond immediately;
